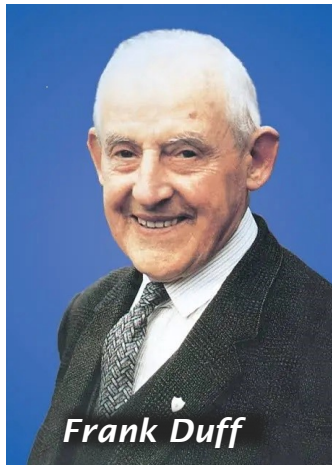
DUBLIN

SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 19

Your full day sightseeing tour takes you to Trinity College to view the famous Book of Kells, Glasnevin Cemetery, burial site of Frank Duff and the Myra House, where the first meeting of the Legion of Mary was held on September 7, 1921 and remains a meeting place today. Nearby is the De Montfort House, the international headquarters of

DUBLIN

SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 20

This morning takes you to the Whitefriar Street Church housing the relics of St. Valentine. Continue your orientation tour as you pass St. Patrick's, Ireland's National Cathedral, Phoenix Park and the fine old Georgian Square of Merrion and Fitzwilliam for which the city is renowned. See Frank Duff's home, the Morning Star and Regina Coeli hostels whose missions are to provide shelter for homeless men and women. Attend the Concilium Legionis Mariae meeting, the highest governing level of the entire Legion worldwide before returning to your hotel. (B)

MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 21

Today's journey takes you from Dublin to Blarney Castle where you will see the legendary Blarney Stone, said to bestow the gift of eloquent speech on those who kiss it. Afterwards drive to Killarney, located in the Kingdom of Kerry. (B,D)

TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 22

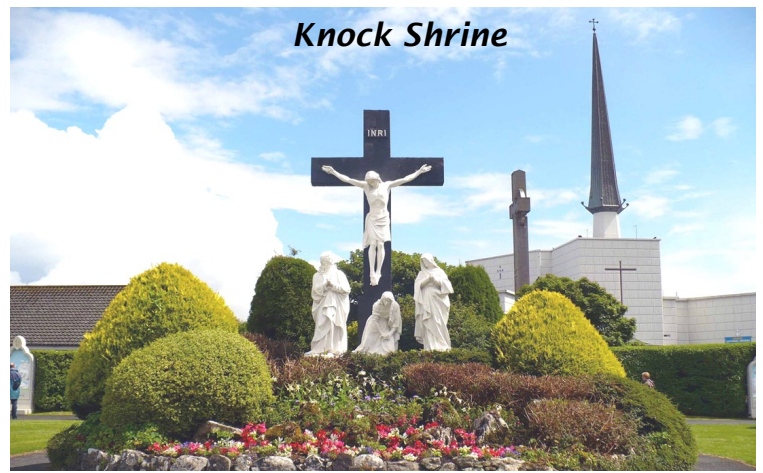

**KILLARNEY/CLIFFS OF MOHER/GALWAY AREA
WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 23**

Drive north today to County Clare past the towns of Limerick and Ennis. Stop in a local village and see the awe-inspiring Cliffs of Moher soaring hundreds of feet above the sea. Continue to Galway, the principal city of western Ireland located at the entrance to Connemara. Overnight in the Galway area. **(B,D)**

**GALWAY AREA/CONNEMARA/GALWAY AREA
THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 24**

Today explore the wild, majestic Connemara region, home of Aran knits. Your tour embraces the rugged country lying between Lough Corrib and the Atlantic Ocean, a breathtaking region of mountain, lake and tiny cottages, visiting Leenane, Clifden and Kylemore Lakes. Here, St. Patrick fasted for 40 days and nights. Return to the Galway area for overnight. **(B,D)**

FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 25**

This morning drive to the village of Knock, set deep in the wild expanse of County Mayo. Knock, the Lourdes of Ireland, is Ireland's premier shrine to our Lady. It was here that the blessed Mother appeared at the little parish church in 1879. Afterwards, return to Dublin for overnight. **(B,D)**
